DAY 1 (Thu): Arrival to Tunisia

Transfer to Tunis by A/C Coach GT (Capacity : From 39 till 55 seats)

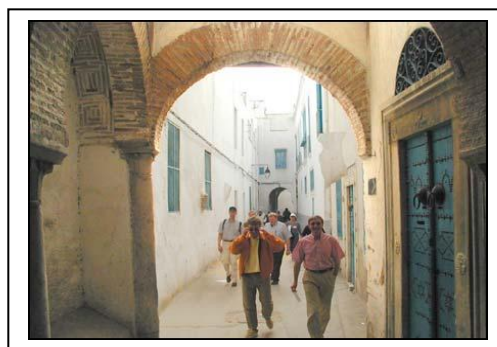
On board the coach GT is a cooler containing a **bottle of water for each guest** per day. Guests are welcome to freely help themselves.

P.S: *It takes usually about one hour between landing, customs, luggage collection and getting on the bus.*

Proceed to **Tunis sightseeing**.

Lunch: End the tour with **lunch at a traditional restaurant “Dar El Jeld”**. *Dar Jeld is a reference point among the finest of Tunisian cuisine as well as a visual feast in its opulent surroundings. The restaurant is in the beautifully restored 18th century home of one of Tunisia’s most prominent families. Its several lounges, dining rooms and patios are furnished with traditional pieces and antiques. A wonderful setting that guests are sure to enjoy.*

Afternoon Proceed to **Sidi Bou Said Andalouse village** in Tunis’ Suburb

The picturesque Andalusian village of Sidi Bou Said is famous for white walls and contrasting blue doors. Sitting in a café overlooking the Tunis Bay & yacht harbour, guests will enjoy a relaxing time for a tea break & some souvenir shopping.



The former palace of Baron d'Erlanger has been converted into a museum and visitors can marvel at the princely splendor of this Arabian Nights "Palace of the Star of Venus". Small shops offer antiques, [Tunisian handicrafts](#), lovely [silver jewelry](#) and the art gallery exhibits works of both Tunisian and international artists. At the foot of the cliffs lies the Port of Sidi Bou Said, a modern marina with [restaurants](#) and [hotels](#). Finish your tour with a visit to La Marsa and Gammarth, nearby elegant beachside suburbs that come alive in the summer with joyous bands of



liberated youth, and don't miss the "Café Saf-Saf" in La Marsa where a snow white camel draws water from a artisan well.

Evening **Dinner** will be served at a gourmet restaurant in this pretty village.

Transfer to hotel by 4WD or carriages

Day 2 (Fri)

Morning **Breakfast**
Transfer by 4WD's to Metlaoui for a regular excursion on The former bey of Tunis' train, the 'Lézard Rouge'.
Beautifully restored and finely appointed, this train will take guests through the spectacular scenery of the Seldja Gorge. Guests could be served served drinks (in extra) as the train ambles through this unique landscape. Two short stops on the way allow for memorable photography.



aving gained vast experience over the past decade in chartering the prestigious and unique train of the Bey "The Red lizard train". This traditional train can be used to transport your guests for an unforgettable journey.

The Red Lizard a magnificent beylical train used by the Hussaynid rulers, and a famous piece of Tunisian national heritage !!.... You discover Selja and Tabedit, witch will offer you a splendid landscape made of Tunnels, Canyons, Rocks and Oueds. This astonishing western decoration was used by the most famous film makers (Franco Zeffirelli, Harisson Ford..) to great effect in their movies..

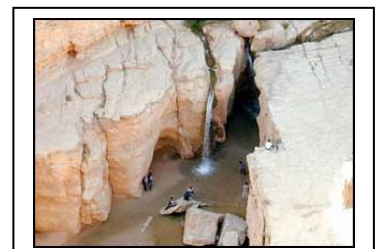


Upon arrival to the terminus, guests return to their 4WD cars and continue towards beautiful **Mides** village.

Transfer to Tamerza

Lunch is served on the terrace of the Tamerza Palace hotel (4*) overlooking ancient Tamerza village.

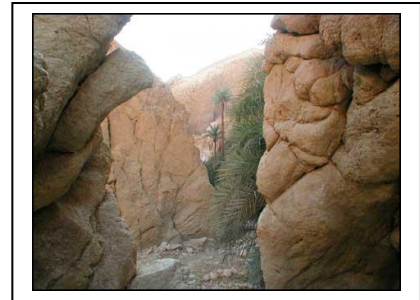
Chebika and Tamerza are a series of lovely mountain oases. Waterfalls and abandoned clay and stone homes make these oases some of the most beautiful in the country. Guests enjoy an unforgettable drive by 4WD along



the winding panoramic road.

Guests may take a refreshing shower under Tamerza's waterfall and marvel at the enormous palm trees growing from cracks in the hard, dry rock.

Fifteen minutes further along the panoramic road, hike back in the silent tranquillity of Chebika's balcony oasis. Non-alcoholic refreshments will be waiting for guests upon return.



Late afternoon Transfer to **Laariguett** by 4WD and via Nefta *Laariguett is the plural of Erg . El Erg is a huge dune*
Laariguett is located at 45 minutes per way from Tozeur (on the north west)

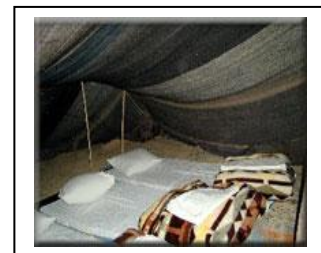


On the way, 4WDs have a **simulation of a technical breakdown** . Guests will continue by **camels** and on the way to the camp they will **visit the desert film location of 'The English Patient' & " STARS WAR "** .
On arriving to the camp, each guest will have a **Certificate of conducting the camel** written in Aarab Language .

A Bedouin lady in typical tent will prepare and show the group how to cook the tabouna (typical bread) .
The bread will be served for dinner
After dinner , a relax tent for those who wish to smoke the water pipe (Chicha) .

Pick up for a half day '**Treasure Hunt**' in Tozeur city

Treasure hunt
This unique activity is a dynamic program that draws on participants' individual strengths, bolsters team spirit and encourages interaction with Tozeur's friendly local community. The large group is initially divided into smaller teams. Starting at the hotel and continuing into Tozeur, clues for the teams to find are hidden in different locations. Each clue provides a challenge to the group and information



necessary to locate the next task. At each point, teamwork and problem solving are necessary for successful completion of the challenge. Explore Tozeur's old quarter, Ouled el-Hadef, to find the clue in the shoe maker's shop, work together to reach the clue hidden in Tozeur Medina ! Groups are always astonished at what they can accomplish through collaboration! Visit Tunisia representatives' presence throughout the activity keeps members motivated and on the right course.

 Evening Wedding reception.

You are invited as guests to a traditional wedding staged in Tozeur's oasis. This fascinating ceremony, as well as the preparations leading up to it, is an event that guests will certainly never forget! Far from passive observation, guests participate in this wonderful celebration. In fact, both the bride and groom are chosen from amongst the guests themselves. Often the youngest man and youngest woman are chosen to play these roles, however suggestions and volunteers are welcome.

'Bride and groom' are dressed in typical traditional wedding garments and all other 'wedding guests' are provided with southern ceremonial garb. Accompanied by a festive folkloric music troupe, the whole "caravan" starts from the hotel, proceeds through the town, through the oasis to the palm grove where an elaborate dinner awaits (see photos). This caravan is a distinguishing characteristic of the southern wedding ceremony. The groom walks with the bridal procession among the guests but the blushing bride rides on a camel. She is hidden inside a "Jehfa", a small tent-like compartment, showing only her hand decorated with henna to ward off evil.

This venue guarantees lots of fun and a wonderful opportunity to experience one of the most celebrated rites in southern Tunisian culture.
