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15.00-18.00 - **Sightseeing tour** with visit of the most remarkable sights of Moscow and stops for taking pictures with visit of **Christ the Savior Cathedral** which was built on the donations of Russian people

### **Day 3**

08.30-10.00 - Transfer to the **Sergiev Passad**- At the entrance to the town from the top of the hill

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there is a breath-taking view of the Trinity Monastery of St.Sergius. The unusually high bell-tower dominates the whole ensemble. The mass of churches and other buildings creates a joyous, uplifting sensation, particularly on sunny days, and recalls pictures of gingerbread town on old woodcuts. This is one of Russians most important and highly revered monasteries, which still retains its greatness and renown. Here lie the relics of Sergius of Radonezh that bring thousands of pilgrims here each year to do homage. The monastery contains a seminary and a very rich library of religious literature.

10.00-12.30 - **Tour of the Sergiev Monastery and vestry**



12.30-14.00 - **Lunch with Monks** - exclusively organized lunch at the seminary where future Russian Orthodox monks study. Food is being server according to the Lent's restrictions

14.00-16.00 – Transfer to Moscow to the Stalin's Bunker

16.00-17.00 - Guided tour of **Stalin's Bunker** – underground complex used for Stalin's secret meetings and as bomb shelter during the Second World War



17.00-18.00 – Transfer to the hotel

18.00-19.30 – Rest at the hotel

19.30-20.00 – Transfer to the restaurant for dinner

20.00-22.30 - **Farewell dinner** at the Palace-like and one of the best restaurants of Moscow-  
“**Turandot**” (interiors- rococo style)

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22.30-23.00 - Transfer to the hotel

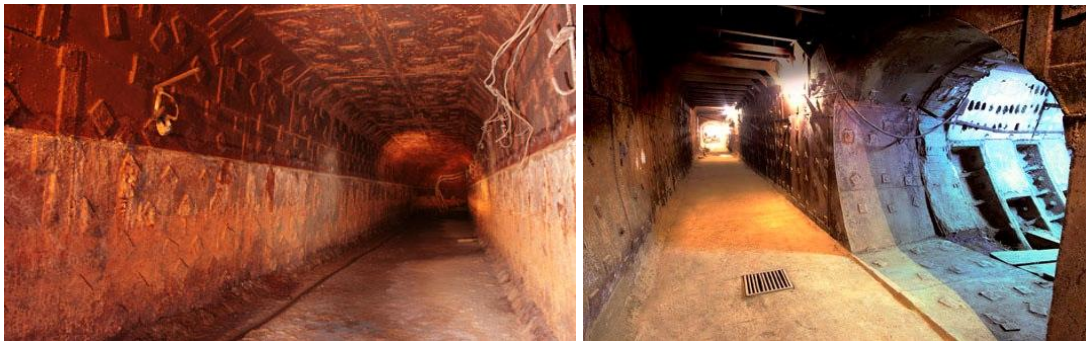
Breakfast at the hotel
