Early arrival at Ben Gurion Airport

Afternoon walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem and Lunch.



Departure for an afternoon tour of the historical city of Jerusalem. Upon arrival the walking tour of the Old City will take the guests through the cobblestone streets of the ancient city. A discovery of Jerusalem's icons will lead to the **Western Wall**, the surviving relic of the magnificent Temple built by Herod. Following the different stations of the **Via Dolorosa** the guests will reach the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, the holiest Christian site in Jerusalem. A visit to the David's Tower located on the highest point in the Old City, allows a stunning view of both the Old and New city of Jerusalem.

Half-day Afternoon Sightseeing – The Dead Sea followed by a Bedouin Feast in the desert.



Depart the hotel by coach, and head to the Dead Sea.

Continue to a **Dead Sea Spa** for a refreshing pause. Part of the Afro-Syrian Rift, the Dead Sea is the **lowest point on earth**, about 380 meters below sea level. Rich in minerals, the Dead Sea attracts vacationers from around the world who come to enjoy the **thermo-mineral springs**, in Dead Sea water, the bromine-saturated air and of course a float in the salty waters is a must! The group will spend time in the Spa of a hotel at the dead sea and freshen up before an evening of excitement.

Cost of half day tour to the Dead Sea with entrance to the spa and private and beach facilities: \$ per person including all transfers.

Bedouin Dinner Feast at Shepherd's Village.

A recreation of the hospitable atmosphere and nomadic tradition of the desert people since the beginning of the creation of culture in our region.

Abraham hosted the angels, the Nabateans and the Arabs continued this tradition and the Bedouins still host their guests according to the unique rules of the desert.

Description of the event:

Guests arrive at the beautiful site in the desert. They will be met by camels upon their arrival for a short camel ride in the desert.

On site, a magnificent Bedouin tent awaits the group, standing with all its authentic colorful ornaments - carpets, rugs, straw mats, mattresses pillows and brass vessels. Guests will enjoy watching pita baking on the open fire, in the traditional way, while the Bedouin invite them for a taste.

Following this welcoming part of the feast, guests will be invited to enter the tent for the primary program to begin. The traditional Bedouin hospitality ceremony will then take place including traditional story telling and the ancient coffee serving ceremony.

Guests will be seated on mattresses, or wooden stools, around low round tables.

Rose water Hand washing ceremony will treat the guests and then the meal is traditionally served on large platters to the centre of the table. A belly dancer will perform for the group during the dinner.

Cost of Bedouin Feast at Shepherd's Village Including Bedouin hospitality and camel ride: \$ per person including wine, fruit juice and beer, (Cost based on 100 people).

After dinner the guests will be transferred back to their hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 05 ~ SATURDAY**Visit to Bethlehem followed by Airport Departure**

Following breakfast and check out of the hotel, the group will depart for Bethlehem . The tour will include a visit to the Church of the Nativity in the heart of Bethlehem, which marks one of Christianity's most sacred sites - the birthplace of Jesus Christ. Situated on Manger Square 8 kilometers (5 miles) from Jerusalem, the church is built over a grotto where the Virgin Mary is said to have given birth to Jesus. Christians have venerated the site since St. Justin Martyr identified it as the site of Jesus' birth in the second century. It is the oldest Church in the Holy Land still in use and one of the oldest churches in the world. Visit Milk Grotto and the Bazaars. After the tour the group will have lunch at a Middle Eastern Restaurant and continue with their late afternoon transfer to the airport for their flight to Moscow.

Morning sightseeing and lunch with transfer to Ben Gurion Airport by private coach: \$ per person
