**DAY 01 ~**

**Arrival At Ben Gurion Airport**

The guests will be met by a representative at the sleeve of the plane who will accompany them through passport control, baggage collection and customs. The group will meet their guide who will transfer them by deluxe coach to the Hotel in Tel Aviv. Duration approximately 35 minutes.

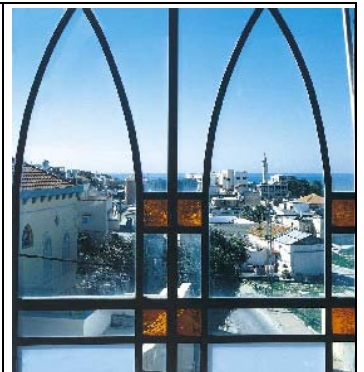
**VIP GOLD Service at arrival:** This type of service includes:

**Afternoon tour of Tel Aviv the “Hill of Spring” and the ancient port of Jaffa.**

Tel-Aviv also boasts **modern architecture**, alongside classic examples of the **Bauhaus school of the 1930's and 1940's** brought to Israel by new immigrant architects at that time. We will visit **Jaffa, one of the World's most ancient port cities**, where stone buildings, narrow passages and picturesque courtyards recall the rich past of this charming city. A visit to the unique underground Visitor's Centre guides the participant through the past two thousand years. Today, Old Jaffa is alive and houses a **thriving artists' colony**. The twisting passages will reveal antiquities and coins, ceramics, silkscreen art, impressionist paintings, hand-woven goods and exquisite jewellery, all born in an atmosphere inspired by the surroundings.



**Dinner at The Unique Urban 4<sup>th</sup> Floor.**



Fourth floor is a unique urban event space character, from the creator of Cafe Noir restaurant Sebastian.

The place is situated in the building industry, the heart of the metropolis, designed stylish spacious loft. Based on

the fourth floor open space area of 800 square meters, designed a residential loft - corners turned, bar, kitchen, library, wine closet stylised toilet stalls. ### DAY 02 ~

#### Full day excursion of Jerusalem with lunch at the King David Hotel

A discovery of Jerusalem's icons will lead to the **Western Wall**, the surviving relic of the magnificent Temple built by Herod. Following the different stations of the **Via Dolorosa** the guests will reach the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, the holiest Christian site in Jerusalem. A visit to the **David's Tower** located on the highest point in the Old City, allows a stunning view of both the Old and New City of Jerusalem.

The conclusion of the visit will be a short drive through the **New City of Jerusalem to view the Parliament building** and continue to the panoramic view of the **Mount of Olives**.

#### Lunch at The King David Hotel, Jerusalem



Located in the heart of the city, overlooking the ancient walls of the Old City, the King David is the Foremost gathering place in Israel. It is where people who make history rub shoulders with people who Come to see it made. The famous hotel is also the traditional host to diplomats and experienced travellers. #### Dinner The Carmella Bistro in Nachlat Binyamin.



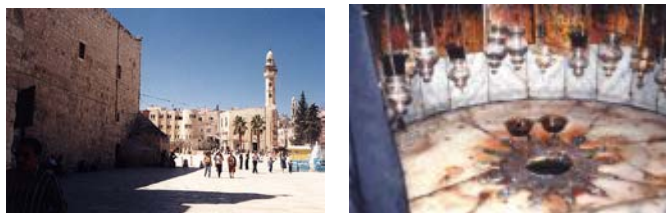

**DAY 03 ~**

Breakfast in the hotel

**Option 1 - Morning visit to Bethlehem followed by The Dead sea**



After Breakfast the group will depart for a short visit in Bethlehem. Aroximately a 90 minute Drive from Tel Aviv. The tour will include a visit to the Church of the Nativity in the heart of Bethlehem, which marks one of Christianity's most sacred sites - the birthplace of Jesus Christ. Situated on Manger Square 8 kilometers (5 miles) from Jerusalem, the church is built over a grotto where the Virgin Mary is said to have given birth to Jesus. Christians have venerated the site since St. Justin Martyr identified it as the site of Jesus' birth in the second century. It is the oldest Church in the Holy Land still in use and one of the oldest churches in the world.

**Continue to The Dead Sea with Fish Lunch at The Ranch Restaurant at Isrotel and Private Mud Festival on the Beach.**



Depart the hotel in Tel Aviv after breakfast for The Dead sea.

Part of the Afro-Syrian Rift, the Dead Sea is the **lowest point on earth**, about 380 meters below sea level. Rich in minerals, the Dead Sea attracts vacationers from around the world who come to enjoy the **thermo- mineral springs**, in Dead Sea water, the bromine-saturated air and of course a float in the salty waters is a must!

Upon arriving at the Isrotel Spa, the group have a whole morning to enjoy a pre-arranged Mud Festival on the hotel's private beach as well as the use of the spa facilities which include the indoor spa pool, out door pool.

Return to Tel Aviv in the afternoon approximately a 2 1/2 hour Drive.

## Option 2

### Full Day tour of Haifa, Acre and Tiberias UNESCO world heritage sites.



The group will depart the hotel in the morning for Haifa. **Haifa**, Israel's major port and third largest city, is often compared to San Francisco because of its hills and its beauty. View the **Bahai Gardens**, overlooking the bustling port of Haifa and the commercial heart of the city with modern stores and restaurants

Continue to **Acre**, on the northern tip of Haifa Bay. The city is almost **4000 years old**. Because of its strategic geographical position Acre had several occupants throughout its history. From the Romans and the Crusaders, who left a beautiful **subterranean city** with gates, towers, tunnels and **secret passageways** to the Arabs who rebuilt and fortified the city in the 18<sup>th</sup> Century.

The journey continues to Tiberias. **Upon arrival to the Sea of Galilee area**, the group will start with a drive through Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene. Stop at the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus proclaimed his Sermon on the Mount. Continue to **Tabgha** and visit the traditional site of the Multiplication Miracle of Loaves and Fishes. On to the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter on the shores of the Sea of Galilee wherein lies the **Rock of Mensa Christi**.



#### **Lunch at The Bat Ya'ar Ranch located 15 minutes outside of Tzfat.**

One of the foremost attractions of Bat Ya'ar is the Dude Ranch, where visitors can enjoy horseback riding. There are horses and trails that are appropriate for beginners as well as for more advanced riders. The conclusion of The Bat Ya'ar visit will be lunch their renowned Steak House, with grilled meats and vegetables served with a wide variety of salads either in the restaurant or outside in the midst of the woods.

**The group will return back to the hotel in time to freshen-up for a night out in Tel- Aviv, the city that never sleeps** (Approximately a 2 hour drive)

**Morning excursion - Drive along the Mediterranean Coast to visit Herod's Caesarea. Morning meeting at The Dan Caesarea with Soccer Match.**



We will drive along the **coastal road to Caesarea**, once the largest city in Judea. On the ruins of an **ancient anchorage**, Herod built a splendid port, which he dedicated **to Augustus Caesar**. A 3000 seat Roman theatre with wonderful acoustics is still used today for summer concerts. The remains of the Crusader City, the **Hippodrome**, a **Byzantine street** with giant headless statues and the **Roman Aqueduct** are also part of the archaeological finds at the site.

**Lunch at Helena Followed by transfer to the airport for Flight Home**



The Helena restaurant is located in the Caesarea Port. From the wooden terrace a panoramic view of the blue sea, the full breadth of the horizon, and the ancient restored harbor of Caesarea, one of Israel's most preserved and beautiful sites can be seen. The magical location and unique scenery create a special atmosphere even prior to the opening of the menu. Helena is a seaside restaurant created by Uri Yarmias and Daniel Zach (Sussenbach of 'Uri Buri' in Acre and 'Carmella Bistro' in Tel Aviv fame). In charge of the food is the talented Chef Amos Sion, who receives free reign from his 2 senior partners and who uses it to good advantage. Sion creates an up-to-date Mediterranean menu of the highest standard, which makes use of local raw ingredients, and touches upon other cuisines. The rich menu offers a wonderful selection of fish, seafood, and meat dishes. These are served with unique side items which create impressive and delicious dishes. The fine menu, the restaurant's classic decor, and the breathtaking view all create a one of a kind culinary experience.
